Council Meeting of May 2, 1967

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Eberth, Eyerly, Raines VanTuyll and Worley.

Others present; John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, JohnMurray, City Attorney, Margaret Sterner, Police Judge and Charles Newman.

Minutes of April 4, 1967 and April 5, 1967 meetings were read and approved.

Treasurers report was read by Richard Warden, treasurer. Eberth moved and seconded by Worley to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Plat for Meyer Second Addition submitted by Martell & Bacon, having been approved by Basehor City Planning & Zoning Commission. Raines moved and seconded by Eyerly to approve plat of Meyer Second Addition. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eberth moved and seconded by Eyerly that the proper authorities be authorized to pay \$2,253.00 on No-Fund Warrants at First State Bank, Tonganoxie, Kansas. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Nominations were in order for President of Council: Worley nominated Councilman Eberth. Seconded by Van Tuyll.

Eyerly moved nominations cease and unanimous vote be cast for Eberth. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer appointed to one year terms the following: John Klinkenberg as City Clerk; Richard Warden ~~and~~ City Treasurer; Cecil Swope as Chief of Police; and John Murray as City Attorney.

Eyerly moved and seconded by Worley to approve appointments announced above by Mayor Meyer. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer appointed Charles Newman to post as Zoning Administrator.

Eberth moved and seconded by ~~Worley~~ Eyerly to approve appointment above. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eyerly moved and seconded by Van Tuyll to set salary schedule for appointees as follows: Clerk \$50.00 per month, Treasurer \$25.00 per month, Chief of Police \$100.00 per month. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eberth moved and seconded by Raines to instruct City Attorney to prepare an ordinance covering dog kennels. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eyerly moved and seconded by Eberth to pay bills submitted for street repairs by Frank Eyerly for \$98.00 and Hauling of patching material by Joe Carney \$8.00. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Request for special permit for installation of a septic tank by Carol B. Riley on 50 foot lot presented, with approval by Zoning-planning commission.

Eberth moved and seconded by Eyerly that the owner be given permit with restriction requiring owner to pump septic tank if it fills and require that owner hook on to sewer within 6 months of date sewers become available. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.
