Council Meeting of June 6, 1967

Minutes of May 2, 1967 meeting was read and approved.

Treasurers report was read by Richard Warden, treasurer. Worley moved and seconded by Raines to accept treasurers report as read. Approved.

Ordinance No. 15 was read for the first time, being an ordinance defining and licensing of Dog Kennels. Raines moved and seconded by Worley to adopt Ordinance No. 15 for First Reading. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Council declared emergency and moved Ordinance No. 15 be read for second reading.

Ordinance No. 15, being an ordinance defining and licensing of Dog Kennels, was read for the second time. Raines moved and seconded by Worley to adopt ordinance No. 15 for the second reading. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Van Tuyl moved and seconded by Eyerly to pay bill for labor & equipment for street repairs totaling \$86.50 by Gail Knoche. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Appropriation Ordinance No. 1 totaling \$480.35. Eyerly moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to approve for payment Bills listed on Appropriation Ordinance No. 1. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Budget hearing date set for August 1, 1967 at 8:00 P.M. at Fairmount Township Hall. Eyerly moved and seconded by Raines to set budget hearing as above. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Next meeting date falls on Holiday July 4, 1967, therefore meeting was rescheduled to the following tuesday July 11, 1967. Raines moved and seconded by Eyerly to reschedule meeting to July 11, 1967. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.
