

CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS
Council Meeting of July 11, 1967

Mayor Meyer called meeting to Order. Councilmen present Eyerly, Raines, Van Tuyl, and Worley.

Others present: John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer.

Minutes of June 6, 1967 meeting was read and approved.

Treasurers report was read by Richard Warden, treasurer. Raines moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Discussion followed on proposal to be submitted for Federal Grant on Sewers. Special meeting set for July 25, 1967 at 8:00 p. m. at which Mr. Bartlett of Bartlett & West and John Murray will explain proposed changes in plans for sewer and financing method.

Letter from County Assessor read stating valuation of City of Basehor is \$599,000.

Following discussion on street oiling and repairing, Eyerly moved and Seconded by Van Tuyl that letter be sent to Mr. E. O. Lunsford requesting that busses not be parked on city streets or in residential drives. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.
