Council Meeting of July 25, 1967

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Eberth, Eyerly, Raines, Van Tuyl and Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, John Murray, City Attorney and Charles West, of Bartlett & West.

Mr. West explained various changes made in plans for sewers at request of FHA.

General discussion followed in which it was decided that a meeting with FHA would be necessary to obtain their thinking in regard to the deletions they requested. Mr West was to sound out FHA in regard to City of Basehor putting in complete system and applying for grant only on portion outlined by FHA.

Mayor Meyer, City Attorney, John Murray and Charles West of Bartlett and West to meet with Cliff Harding of FHA if appointment can be arranged by Mr. West and report back to council at meeting August 22, 1967.

John Murray to get valuation figures for central city as outlined by FHA proposal and forward them to Mr. West so revised estimate can be prepared for meeting with FHA.
