COUNCIL MEETING OF AUGUST 22, 1967

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Council members present Eberth, Eyerly, Raines and Worley.

Others present John Murray, Attorney, John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Charles West and Charles Morline of Bartlett & West.

Budget hearing scheduled for 8:00 called to order and in absence of any citizens action deferred until completion of meeting with Engineers and Attorney.

Mr. West of Bartlett & West informed council that FHA grant would not be forthcoming inasmuch as all grants for sewers systems had been withdrawn for the foreseeable future. Mr. West outlined proposed method of financing sewers without Federal grant, \$99,000.00 in general obligation bonds, \$35,000.00 in bonds to be retired by school district and balance, \$160,000.00 in revenue bonds to be retired by sewer service charge.

Council members to take proposal home for study. Action postponed until next council meeting.

Budget hearing opened. On motion for adoption of budget as published councilmen voted as follows: Eberth, Yea, Eyerly, Yea, Raines, Yea, Worley, Yea. Van Tuly, not present. Budget adopted.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
