COUNCIL MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 5, 1967

Mayor-Pro-tem Eberth called meeting to order. Councilmen present Eberth, Raines, Van Tuyl and Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, Richard Warden, treasurer, Fred Sterner & Ward Kiester.

Minutes of August 1, 1967 and August 22, 1967 meetings were read and approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden, treasurer. Worley moved and seconded by Raines to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Resignation from Fred Eyerly read by city clerk. Van Tuyl moved and seconded by Raines to accept Fred Eyerly's resignation by reason of moving from city. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Street naming plan as proposed by planning commission was opened for discussion. A call was made for volunteers to meet with the planning commission to determine their thinking and to see if what is proposed can be done. Van Tuyl, Worley and Warden to meet with planning commission at their next meeting. Raines moved and seconded by Worley to table the proposed plan until next council meeting, except for the above three to meet with planning commission. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mr. Kiester requested City to install 30 ft. tube at service entrance to grade school and bill the school district.

Discussed putting No U Turn sign in front of Junior High School at the request of Police Chief. No action taken following discussion which was of the opinion that it would not solve problem and create other problems.

Dog catching problem came up again. Mr. Swope to be contacted by Mr. Eberth in regard to price and equipment needed.

Raines moved and seconded by Worley to adjourn. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.
