COUNCIL MEETING OF DECEMBER 5, 1967

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Robert Raines, Charles Kemler, Robert Van Tuyl and Lester Worley.

Others present - John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden City Treasurer, and John Murray City Attorney.

Minutes of November 7, 1967 meeting was read and approved.

Treasurers report was read by Richard Warden, treasurer. Van Tuyl moved and seconded by Worley to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Application of A. K. Mussett to build a house on two 75 x 132 ft. lots in Petherbridge addition two, 1800 sq. ft. short of $\frac{1}{2}$ acre for lot size. Eberth moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to refer application to planning commission for their recommendation. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Problem of dogs at school brought up. Suggestion was made to have School principal notify parents of offending dogs of problem.

New sewer proposal presented by Mayor Meyer. Proposal studied but no action taken.

Raines moved and seconded by Eberth to ask Chief of Police to prepare and submit to council a written monthly report of activities for preceding month, such report to list tickets issued and warnings given and to whom given. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.
