

Council meeting of January 4, 1966

Mayor Bryan called the meeting to order. Roll was call and all members were present.

The minutes were read and approved.

Ordinance No. 9 was placed on final reading. Councilman Meyer moved to adopt Ordinance No. 9, Councilman Meints second, it was adopted by a veto of 5 to 0.

There^was a discussion of the possibility of additional street lights in the southwestern part of the city. It was decieded that a study by the councilmen be made and report back next meeting.

Councilman Eberth moved Mr. Leon Riley be given a permit to construct a sepic system under conditions set forth to the previous case of Mr. Banzhof.

The police chief appeared to negotate his salary. A motion was made to pay the police chief \$60.00 per month retroactive to his employment being subject to revission depending on furture cost. It was second by Worley passed by a veto of 5 to 0.

E..M. Hein was nominated by Mayor Bryan as city clerk. Nomination was disapproved with Councilmen Meyer, Worley and Ebert voting against, Councilmen Askew and Meints voting for.

Mr. Askew would be acting city clerk until a perment appoinment was made.

The township board agreed to have printed 3,30 mile speed limit signs for the city.

A motion to ajorn was made by councilman Meyer, second by Councilman Meints passed 5 to 0.
