

Council Meeting of March 1, 1966

Mayor Bryan called meeting to order. Council members present Askew, Eberth, Meints, Worley and Meyer.

Minutes of February 3, 1966 and February 10, 1966 meetings were read and approved.

Worley moved and seconded by Askew that city have light company reduce bulb size in light by Grube & Eberth's places to conform with size bulb in other street lights in town and for the city then to assume payment for said light. Approved 5 votes in favor, 0 votes opposed.

Treasurers report read. Moved by Meyer and seconded by Meints to accept treasurer's final report from Donald Robert Skaggs. Approved 5 votes in favor, 0 votes opposed.

Worley moved and seconded by Eberth to grant special building permit to Fred Scheller to tear down house and put up a new building. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Meyer moved and seconded by Eberth to authorize Robert Knoche to act as agent for city in approving and accepting all streets constructed in city of Basehor, until further notice. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eberth moved to adjourn. Approved, as there was no further business.
