

Council Meeting of March 15, 1966.

Councilman Meyer called meeting to order in the absence of Mayor Bryan. Council members present Meyer, Eberth, Worley, Askew and Meints.

Minutes of March 1, 1966 meeting were read and approved.

At a public meeting held March 10, 1966 at Basehor High School building a proposed Sewer System was presented to approximately 150 people of Basehor in attendance. Presentations by Ben Boyer, Leavenworth County Health Department, Harry Bartlett of Bartlett & West Consulting Engineers, and Ed Jones of Columbian Securities were made followed by questions from the audience to speakers and Howard Duncan of State Board Department of Health. At the end of the meeting a public opinion poll was taken and the result of that vote was 93 in favor of proposed sewer system and 31 opposed to proposed sewer system.

Eberth moved and seconded by Worley that city attorney and Bartlett & West be authorized to complete necessary papers to be submitted to Federal Government for Federal grant for Sewage system, for signature of city officials. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

In the absence of Mayor Bryan Mr. Meyer submitted name of Mr. Eberth as street commissioner. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eberth moved and seconded by Worley to authorize Frank Eyerly to be issued permit for addition of walk-in cooler onto restaurant if in accordance with national building code and roof and siding be in accordance with present building appearance. Approved 5 in favor 0 votes opposed.

Meyer moved and seconded by Askew that city pay paper bill for printing of zoning ordinance prepared by planning commission, and that city pay Fred Hein for cleaning up after and setting up of chairs for March 10, 1966 public meeting. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.
