

Council Meeting of June 7, 1966

Councilman Meyer called meeting ot order. Council members present Worley, Meints, Meyer.

Others present Ted Coble and wife, Bob Breuer and Jerry Strouhal, John Klinkenberg and Jim Pantle.

Minutes of May 3, 1966 meeting were read.

Treasurers report was read by city treasurer. Worley moved and seconded by Meints to accept treasurers report. Approved 3 in favor 0 opposed.

Worley moved and seconded by Meints to accept Mayor Bryan's resignation as Mayor. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer nominated Joe Schwartz as replacement councilman. Worley moved and seconded by Meints to accept nomination. Approved unanimously.

Councilman Joe Schwartz was sworn in to office by city clerk.

Mrs. Coble presented sewage problem in Klam addition. Discussed same and agreement obtained from Bob Breuer to follow Health Dept. recommendations for correcting same, insofar as it came from his property.

Ordinance No. 11 being an ordinance regulating, licensing, registering and keeping of dogs was read for the third time. Meints moved and seconded by Worley to adopt ordinance No. 11 forthe third reading. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Ordinance No. 12 being an ordinance titled Green River Ordinance, was read for the ~~third~~ time. Schwartz moved and seconded by Meints to adopt ordinance No. 12 for the third reading. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Worked over proposed budget for 1967.

Meints moved and seconded by Worley that City of Basehor join League of Kansas Municipalities for one (1) year and authorize payment of dues to same. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Worley moved and seconded by Meints to adjourn. Approved 3 votes in fowor 0 votes opposed.
