

COUNCIL MEETING OF JULY 20, 1966

Mayor Meyer called meeting ~~to~~ order. Council members present Askew, Eberth, Meints, Schwartz and Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, city clerk.

Discussed oiling of streets in the town. Township proposed to furnish sand or chat and to do grading on streets that the city wants to oil in 1966. Discussed cost and method of financing. Decided to secure additional information from city attorney and county engineer and contractor.

Nominations were in order for President of Council. Councilman Meints nominated ED Askew. Seconded by Councilman Eberth. Councilman Schwartz moved nominations cease. Councilman Askew elected 4 votes in favor, 0 votes opposed, 1 abstained.

Schwartz moved and seconded by Worley to double building permit fee if any construction is started before securing building permit, or no permit issued if fee is not paid. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
