

Council Meeting of August 3, 1966

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Council members present Eberth, Meints,
^{Schwartz}~~Meints~~ and Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City clerk, and John Murray, City attorney.

Minutes of July 5 and July 20, 1966 meetings were read and approved.

Eberth moved and seconded by Worley to have map corrected to December 1965 and have the map issued. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eberth moved and seconded by Worley to oil streets in City of Basehor that are 18 feet or wider travelled area, graded up and ready for oiling as of now, two coats of oil; Remaining streets graded as soon as possible and put in shape for oiling. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Schwartz moved and seconded by Meints to issue No Fund Warrants in the amount of \$2,500.00 for street repairs. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eberth moved and seconded by Worley that budget as published be adopted on reduction of budgeted amounts of street supplies and equipment rental by \$2,500.00, and with the addition of \$2,500.00 to No Fund Warrants outstanding in payment of 1966 street oiling and repair. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer appointed Leroy Swope deputy police chief in absence of chief of police.

~~Worley~~ moved and seconded by Eberth to accept ~~nominations~~ appointment. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

James Pantle submitted his resignation as city treasurer.

Meints moved and seconded by Eberth to accept James Pantle's resignation if and when the city can get someone to take his place as City treasurer. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer appointed ~~Richard~~ Warden city treasurer

Worley moved and seconded by Schwartz to approve the appointment of Richard C. Warden as City Treasurer. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eberth moved and seconded by Meints that meeting adjourn. Approved.


