

COUNCIL MEETING OF JULY 2, 1965

The first council meeting was called to order by mayor Bryan.

All members were present.

Councilman Meyer said, Murry-Attorney at Law would not have any charges against the city. Murry stated that the only charge would be on a bond issue, where there is not a bond issue that charge would be small unless he had to make to many trips to the meetings. A discussion followed.

Councilman Meyer said, the three things they have to do were; set a meeting night, get a clerk, and appoint a lawyer.

It is then noted that the Mayor has a veto on any issue but could not vote and break a tie.

Councilman Meints, moved to approve Mayor Bryan's nomination of Donald R. Hein as city clerk. Ed. Askew second. The motion was passed by a majority.

Councilman Meyer, nominated John Murry - Attorney at Law as city attorney. Les Worley second, there were no other nomations. Barney Eberth moved nomations cease, Mayro Bryan called for a vote, on Murry's nomation. Councilmen, Askew, Eberth, Meyer and Worley voted for Murrys nomation. Councilmen Meints obtained, Murry was appointed City Attorney. A discussion of Murry followed.

The Matter of a time and date of meetings was discussed. Councilmen Meints, moved the regular meeting to be held on the first Tuesday of the month at 8:00PM. It was second by Councilmen Meyer and adopted unanimously.

Mayor Bryan asked Councilmen Meyer to notify Murry of his appointment as City Attorney.

A discussion of various issues to be brought up at furture meetings followed. The minutes were read and approved.

Councilman Meints, moved to adjorn the meeting, Councilman Meyer second, vote on adjornment was unanimous.
