

COUNCIL MEETING OF JULY 20, 1965

Mayor Bryan called the meeting to order. All members were present.

The city attorney submitted the following ordinances to the council:

Ordinance NO. 1 prescribing when the regular meetings of the council would be held, was read for the first time and approved unanimously.

Ordinance NO. 2 designating the official paper for the city was read for the first time and approved unanimously.

Ordinance NO. 3 creating a city planning commission was read for the first time and approved unanimously.

Ordinance NO. 4 establishing a zoning plan for the city was read for the first time and approved by an unanimous vote, after setting a minimum square footage of 1000, and adding a section regulating lot size and sewage disposal.

A motion was made by councilman Meints to adopt the Uniform Traffic Code as Ordinance NO. 5, it was second by councilman Meyer, It was adopted unanimously. The city attorney would obtain the code and prepare the ordinance adopting it.

The city attorney would also prepare an agreement for the township to make a levee for the fire department against the City of Basehor.

The city attorney informed the council of the maximum mill levy, (9). He then produced the no-fund warrants for the council to consider.

Mayor Bryan nominated Bob Skaggs as city treasurer, it was second by councilman Worley. It carried with councilman Worley, Meyer, Eberth, and Askew voting for, and councilman Meints voting against.

There was a discussion of the nominations to the city planning commission.

The minutes were read and approved.

Councilman Eberth moved meeting be adjourned, councilman Meints second, it carried unanimously.
