

COUNCIL MEETING OF AUGUST 29, 1965

The meeting was called to order by Chairman J. A. Meyer. Mayor Bryan was absent, all other members were present.

Councilman Eberth moved that the reading of the minutes be dispensed with, councilman Worley second, it was approved unanimously and so ordered.

Chairman Meyer stated the reason for the special meeting was to hear an appeal on the refusal of a building permit to the applicant Mr. A. K. Mussett.

Mr. Mussett then stated his case asking the council to grant his permit as applied for.

After deliberation by the council the Chairman stated that Mr. Mussett could either withdraw the pending application and reapply for a new permit conforming to Ordinance No. 4, however if he could obtain the extra 13 ft. dept he needed he could drop one lot from the permit, or have the council vote on the pending application. He then stated that the council would have to obtain legal council before a decision on the violation of Ordinance No. 4 by Mr. Mussett could be reached. And that no further action would be taken until September 7, 1965.

Mr. Mussett stated that he would withdraw the application and apply for a new permit.

Councilman Askew moved to pay the Chief of Police his balance of \$105.00. It was second by Councilman Worley, it was adopted unanimously.

Councilman Meints moved that the meeting be ajorned, it was second by Councilman Worley, it carried unanimously.
