

COUNCIL MEETING OF AUGUST 3, 1965

Mayor Bryan called the meeting to order. Councilman Meints was absent. All other members were present.

The minutes of the July 20 meeting were read and approved.

Ordinance No. 1 was read for the second time and approved with councilmen Askew, Worley, Eberth, and Meyer voting aye.

A resolution between the city and the township for the fire department was read.

Mayor Bryan moved the resolution be accepted, it was second by councilman Worley, it was accepted unanimously.

Councilman Meyer moved that the city issue a no-fund warrant in the amount of \$500 to the First State Bank of Tonganoxie, it was second by councilman Worley. It was approved unanimously.

Councilman Askew moved that the City Clerk, Treasurer, and the Police Judge be bonded in the amount of \$1000.00. It was second by councilman Meyer, it was passed unanimously.

Councilman Meyer moved that the chief of police obtain the necessary information on the items for his office, and for him to order the ticket books. Councilman Eberth second, and it was approved unanimously.

Councilman Meyer moved that the city clerk be paid \$25.00 a month retro-active to July 1, and the city treasurer \$15.00 a month effective August 1. It was second by councilman Worley, it was approved unanimously.

The councilmen recommended that the chief of police check his expenses for two months and then negotiate his salary with the city.
