

Council Meeting of October 5, 1965

Meeting called to order by Mayor Bryan, City Clerk Donald R. Hein was absent. Councilman Meyer was asked to be acting ^{Clerk} secretary for the meeting.

Roll call found all members of council and Mayor present. Minutes of September 7, 1965 meeting were read and approved. Treasurer report was read and approved. A representative of the Kansas Power and Light Co. read their Franchise with the city as a 3rd and final reading of Ordinance 6. Councilmen Meintz made motion to accept the ordinance #6, second by Councilmen Worley. All councilmen voted yes.

Mr. Murry stated that emergency reading of the gas franchise were not allowed. Councilmen Eberth made motion seconded by Councilmen Worley that we recend the emergency reading of gas franchise Ordinance #7 on Sept. 7 2nd reading of Ordinance #7 by ~~John Murry motion~~ made to accept Ordinance #7 by Councilmen Meintz, seconded by Councilmen Worley, all councilmen voted yes.

Mr. Bacon of Leavenworth gave the city a price of \$150.00 to make a map of Basehor, it was decided to check with Mrs. Johnson who is working on a map before giving Mr. Bacon an answer.

Ben Boyer from Leavenworth County Health Dept gave a talk and showed slides of Basehor's sewage problems. With Boyer were Howard Duncan and David Jackson from the State Health Dept. Jim Baird from Linwood, and Harry Bartlett, with Bartlett and West Engineering Dept of Topeka. Mr. Baird showed a film of Linwood's Lagoon and the construction of Linwood's sewage system. Howard Duncan gave talk and showed figures comparing other towns the size of Basehor.

He also figured out a rough estimate of cost of a system for Basehor. Mr. Duncan told councilmen that if they were interested, the proper procedure would be to hire engineer to take survy and get actual costs and then call public meeting to get opinion of citizens of the city before any action should be taken.

Mr. Bartlett agreed to take a survy of Basehor for \$400.00 to be taken from his commission if his firm was hired.

Motion made to hire Bartlett and West for Survey by Councilmeyer Worley, seconded by Councilmen Askew, all councilmen voted yes Councilmeyer Askew made motion to adjorn.
