

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-11

RESOLUTION PROVIDING NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED ASSESSMENTS AS TO THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE 155TH STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND THE BASEHOR BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Basehor, Kansas (the "City") has heretofore authorized certain internal improvements (the "Improvements") to be constructed pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a01 *et seq.* (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the total final costs of such Improvements has been determined and a Statement of Final Costs for each project is on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Assessment Roll for each of such Improvements has been determined and is on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the governing body desires to call a public hearing with respect to the proposed assessments.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:


Section 1. A public hearing shall be conducted by the Governing Body of the City, at City Hall, 2620 N. 155th Street, on June 18, 2012 at 7:00 p.m., to consider proposed assessments as to the Improvements described in the notice of public hearing attached hereto as Exhibit A, the total costs of which have been determined. The proposed assessments rolls have been or will be placed on file with the office of the City Clerk and open for public inspection, all in accordance with K.S.A. 12-6a09, as amended.


Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to provide notice of the public hearing (in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A) by publication at least once, not less than 10 days prior to such hearing, and to further mail to the owners of the property proposed to be made liable for these assessments at their last known post office address, a notice of the hearing and a statement of the costs proposed to be assessed against the land owned and assessed.
