

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Resolution No. 2006-08

WHEREAS, the City of Basehor, Kansas has prepared an application for an Economic Development Project for FY 2010 funding through the Kansas Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Basehor desires to improve 155th Street from U.S. Highway 24-40 north to Parallel Road, from an existing 24-foot wide ditch section street to a 36-foot wide three-lane street with curb and gutter, storm sewer and street lights at an estimated total cost in FY 2010 dollars of \$2,833,502; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to reserve adequate funding in the 2007 and subsequent years in the Capital Improvement Fund to cover the cities cost of the project estimated at \$833,502; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project has the potential to enhance significantly the income, employment, sales receipts, and land values of the surrounding area in the central part of the City of Basehor;

Now therefore, be it resolved by the governing body of the city of Basehor, Kansas;

That the application for the economic development grant is approved and the city administrator is authorized to sign the application and submit prior to the August 1, 2006 deadline.
