

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-01

A RESOLUTION IDENTIFYING THE CITY OF BASEHOR FUNDING NEEDS FOR THE LEAVENWORTH COUNTY ONE-PERCENT (1%) SALES TAX INITIATIVE.

WHEREAS, the City of Basehor in collaboration with the Leavenworth County Commission has identified the need to continue the countywide retailers' sales tax of one-percent (1%); and,

WHEREAS, the City of Basehor has many unfounded capital improvement needs; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Basehor supports the Leavenworth County One-Percent (1%) Sales Tax Initiative; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Basehor in joint initiative with the Leavenworth County Commission will work for an equitable program that addresses the needs of the communities as well as the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the City of Basehor has identified funding needs for the countywide retailers' sales tax of one-percent (1%) effective for a period of ten (10) years commencing January 1, 2007, and expiring December 31, 2016.

Section 2. That the City of Basehor proposes to use their share of the countywide one percent (1%) sales tax for the following:


- Improvements to 155th Street
- Overlay Original Town of Basehor
- Overlay Petherbridge Subdivision
- Overlay Klamm Subdivision
- Overlay Crestwood Subdivision
- Ditch project and any curbs that may be necessary.
- Capital Improvement Projects
- Equipment Reserve Projects
- Infrastructure Projects

Section 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effective after adoption.
