**RESOLUTION NO. 2004-05**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE CONDEMNATION OF THE STRUCTURES AT 3036 N. 156<sup>TH</sup> STREET, CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the City of Basehor, Kansas, has received a statement from the Building Official stating the structures located at 3036 N. 156<sup>th</sup> Street, city of Basehor, Kansas are unfit, unsafe, and dangerous.

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the City of Basehor, Kansas shall hold a Public Hearing on August 9, 2004 in the meeting room of Basehor City Hall at 6:00 p.m. to allow Robert Eberth, owner, any occupant, or lien holder of record to appear and show cause why such structures should not be condemned and ordered repaired or demolished.

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the City of Basehor, Kansas passed a motion to adopt said Resolution at its June 14, 2004 meeting.

**WHEREAS**, a copy of this resolution shall be published in the official City newspaper once each for two (2) consecutive weeks at least 30 days prior to said hearing date.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Basehor, Kansas, that on August 9, 2004 in the meeting room of Basehor City Hall at 6:00 p.m., a Public Hearing will be held to allow the owner, occupants, and any lien holder of record to appear and show cause why the structures on the property located at 3036 N. 156<sup>th</sup> Street, Basehor, Kansas, should not be condemned and ordered repaired or demolished.
