WHEREAS public awareness and understanding of the importance of industry to the local economy and quality of life is vital to the maintenance of a favorable industrial climate; and


WHEREAS a favorable industrial climate is a major factor in the decision of officials of existing plants to expand their operations and in the attraction of new industry:
