ORDINANCE NO. 495

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE 399 PERTAINING TO MUNICIPAL COURT COSTS. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL SUPERSEDE ANY PRIOR ORDINANCE THAT CONFLICTS WITH THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, LEAVENWORTH COUNTY, KANSAS:

Section 5 shall be amended as follows:

Section 5. In accordance with KSA 12-4117 moneys received from court costs levied and moneys received from any fines, forfeitures, or penalties imposed by the municipal court judge shall be deposited in the general fund money market account. Therefore shall be paid to the treasurer of the State of Kansas, \$19.50 for every conviction. The remainder of moneys received from court costs and fines, forfeitures, and penalties shall be paid to the general fund of the city, and expended therefore as governing body shall deem necessary and prudent.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force after July 1, 2006 and following publication in the *Basehor Sentinel*, the official newspaper of the City of Basehor, Kansas.
