

**ORDINANCE NO. 442
Elected Officials Compensation**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, That on May 7, 1990, the City of Basehor adopted ordinance No. 231 which established a monthly stipend for the Mayor and City Council of \$1.00/month/person. This stipend was to be paid in a lump sum at the end of each calendar year.

WHEREAS, That on November 15, 1999, Resolution 99-12 was adopted by the City of Basehor, which provided that the Mayor would receive an annual salary of \$9,000.00 and that the City Council stipend was to be maintained at \$1.00/month/per City council member.

WHEREAS, That the Mayor of the City of Basehor and the City Council believe that would be in the best interest of the City of Basehor to revise the compensation schedule to be paid to the Mayor and City Council members.

WHEREAS, That Ordinance # 231 and Resolution 99-12 should be revoked in their entirety and the following substituted therefore:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS, THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and the five city council members shall each receive a stipend of \$100.00 per month. The Mayor and five council members will be paid the first two pay periods of each month less any appropriate payroll deductions.

SECTION 2. The annual compensation to be paid to the Mayor and the five city council members shall be increased each year at a rate not to exceed the rate of salary increases received by City employees in general.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall repeal Ordinance # 231 and Resolution 99-12 in their entirety.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective the first pay period subsequent to the publication of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
