

ORDINANCE NO. 408

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE TIMES AND PLACE OF MUNICIPAL COURT SESSIONS AMENDING BASEHOR ORDINANCE, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 9-103.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

Section 1. Basehor Ordinance, Article 1, Section 9-103 shall be amended to read as follows:

TIME AND PLACE OF SESSIONS. Municipal court shall be held in the municipal courtroom in the city hall building on the 2nd Tuesday of each month, commencing at 1:00 p.m. In the event that the court session day shall fall on any legal holiday or any day observed as a holiday by the city offices, the governing body shall fix the succeeding day not observed as a holiday as the court session day.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper of the City of Basehor, Kansas, as provided by law. The first court session to be held on a Tuesday afternoon shall commence with the session scheduled for June 10th, commencing at 1:00 p.m.
