

ORDINANCE NO. 275

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A CITY RETAILER'S SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (.5%) WITHIN THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 1995.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

Section 1. A majority of the electors voting thereon having approved, at a special question election held on the 4th day of April, 1995, the levying of a Retailer's Sales Tax in the City of Basehor, Kansas, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., as amended; there is hereby levied a city retailers' sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent (.5%) to take effect on the first day of October, 1995.

Section 2. Except as may otherwise be provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailer's sales tax shall apply to such city retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The service of the Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to establish an "Infrastructure Fund". All revenues received hereunder shall be deposited in said fund, and shall be used only for the purpose of funding projects that will build, improve or maintain the infrastructure of the City.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be published once in the official city newspaper, and a copy duly certified shall be submitted to the State Director of Taxation.
