

ORDINANCE NO. 405

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE MEETING TIMES OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR AND ESTABLISHING A REGULARLY SCHEDULED WORK SESSION AMENDING BASEHOR ORDINANCE, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 1-203.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

Section 1. Basehor Ordinance, Article 1, Section 1-203 shall be amended to read as follows:

SAME; MEETINGS (a) Effective May 1, 2003, regular meetings of the governing body of the City of Basehor shall be held on the 2nd Monday and the 4th Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. In the event that the regular meeting day shall fall on any legal holiday or any day observed as a holiday by the city offices, the governing body shall fix the succeeding day not observed as a holiday as a meeting day.

(b) Special meetings may be called by the mayor or acting mayor, on the written request of any three members of the council, specifying the object and purpose of such meeting, which request shall be read at a meeting and entered at length on the journal.

(c) Regular or special meetings of the governing body may be adjourned for the completion of its business at such subsequent time and place as the governing body shall determine in its motion to adjourn.

(d) Effective May 1, 2003, a work session of the governing body of the City of Basehor shall be held on the 3rd Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. In the event that the regular worksession meeting day shall fall on any legal holiday or any day observed as a holiday by the city offices, the governing body shall fix the succeeding day not observed as a holiday as a meeting day.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper of the City of Basehor, Kansas, as provided by law.
