

ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ENLARGEMENT OF THE TERRITORY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the boundaries

of the City of Basehor, Kansas, be enlarged and extended to include the following described tract of land, to-wit:

A tract of land in the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Ten (10) South, Range Twenty-two (22) East.

More fully described: Beginning at a point 30.00 feet West of the Southeast corner of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section Twenty-seven (27); thence (North) 870.00 feet; thence (N 89 35' 29" W) 350.00 feet; thence (South) 870.00 feet; thence (S 89 35' 29" E) 350.00 feet to the point of beginning, all in Leavenworth County, Kansas,

which land adjoins the City and a written Petition for and consent to annexation thereof, is filed with the City of Basehor, by

the owners thereof.

Section 2. That no proceedings are necessary other than this Ordinance of the City of Basehor, Kansas, because said territory sought to be included within the enlargement of the boundaries of the City of Basehor, adjoins the City of Basehor, and a written Petition and Consent to this annexation is filed with the City by the owners thereof, all as provided in K. S. A. 12-520.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City paper.
