

ORDINANCE

229

AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING AND INCORPORATING CERTAIN LAND WITHIN THE LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

Section 1.

That the following described land meeting one or more of the conditions of annexation as prescribed by K.S.A. 12-520 is hereby included and brought within the corporate limits of the City of Basehor, Kansas, as requested by the owner by written petition, to-wit:

A tract of land in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-five (35), in the Township Ten South (10 S), Range Twenty-two East (22 E) of the sixth P.M. described as follows: Beginning at a point 204 feet more or less south and 140 feet east of the Southwest corner of Lot Seventeen (17), Petherbridge Addition, Leavenworth County, Kansas in Section Thirty-five (35), Township Ten (10), Range Twenty-two (22), said point being on the center line of the abandoned railroad right-of-way of the Kansas City Wyandotte and Northwestern Railroad, thence northeasterly along said center line on a curve of 3° 00' with a radius of 1° 10 feet, 375 feet more or less; then continuing easterly along said center line of said railroad to a point due south of the Southeast corner of the Charles W. Millison and Esther C. Millison tract as described in Book 386, page 305 in the Register of Deeds office of Leavenworth County, Kansas; thence north to the southeast corner of said Millison tract; thence westerly along the South line of said Millison tract to the South line of Martha Street; then southwesterly along the South line of said Martha Street 375 feet more or less to a point 140 feet east of the West line of the Petherbridge Addition; thence south 133 feet more or less to the point of beginning,

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall incorporate by reference the Annexation Agreement executed between the City of Basehor and Frances E. Eberth providing for the extension of 154th Street or 153rd Terrace through the above described property to be annexed.


Section 3.
