ORDINANCE NO. 482

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS REPEALING
ORDINANCE NO. 454 AND CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 15 OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the governing body of the city of Basehor, Kansas (the "City") has previously adopted Ordinance No. 454 establishing a quasi-sewer benefit district regarding the 24/40 Sanitary Sewer Interceptor project and Charter Ordinance No. 15 establishing a sewer hook on fee for the 24/40 Sanitary Sewer Interceptor project; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it advisable to repeal Ordinance No. 454 and Charter Ordinance No. 15, as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repealer. Ordinance No. 454 of the City, passed and approved on January 24, 2005, is hereby repealed. Charter Ordinance No. 15 of the City, passed and approved on January 31, 2005, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance become effective after its passage and approval by the governing body and publication one time in the official city newspaper.
