

ORDINANCE NO. 651

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 44, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 44-150, ENTITLED "TRUCKS, BUSES, ETC., PARKING RESTRICTED", OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, LEAVENWORTH COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the City Council of the City of Basehor desires to amend Chapter 44, Article IV, Section 44-150 of the City Code of the City of Basehor, Kansas, entitled "Trucks, buses, etc., parking restricted".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 44, Article IV, Section 44-150 of the City Code of the City of Basehor, Kansas, shall be amended with the addition of the underlined language, and the deletion of the stricken language as follows:

Sec. 44-150. - Trucks, buses, etc., parking restricted.

(a) It shall be unlawful to drive park any bus, truck, box truck, tractor, tractor-trailer combination, industrial equipment, or like conveyances having a state licensing rating gross vehicle mass of 26M (13 tons or 26,000 pounds), or more, upon any city residential street within the city unless such vehicle is picking up or delivering merchandise to a location that is only accessible via residential city streets. Its shall be unlawful to park such vehicle picking up or delivering merchandise to a location that is only accessible via residential city streets on the residential any city street for any period of time exceeding two hours. For the purpose of this section, the term "tractor" shall include both road tractors and farm tractors.

~~(b) It shall be unlawful for any bus (excluding any school buses), truck, box truck, tractor, tractor-trailer combination, industrial equipment, or like conveyances having a state licensing rating gross vehicle weight of 26M (13 tons or 26,000 pounds) or more to drive or park upon any residential street within the city unless such vehicle is picking up or delivering merchandise to a location that is only accessible via the residential street.~~

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of the ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.


