ORDINANCE NO. 475

ORDER AMENDING CHAPTER XI, PUBLIC OFFENSES, SECTION 5, 11-205,  
CURFEW, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR,  
KANSAS:

**Section 5.** Section 11-205 of the code of the City of Basehor is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-205. **CURFEW.** (a) Persons under the age of 15 years are prohibited from congregating, frequenting, playing or loitering upon the street, sidewalk, alley or public grounds in the city between the hours of 10:30 p.m., and 6:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, both inclusive, and 11:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday, both inclusive unless accompanied by a parent, guardian or a person of the age of 21 years or more with parental or guardian approval; or, unless such minor is engaged in some business or occupation which such minor may lawfully engage in making it necessary to be in such places after said curfew, or unless the minor specified in this section is attending with the consent of parent or guardian, an approved school function that would extend beyond the curfew deadline specified in this subsection.

(b) Persons of the age 16-18 years of age are prohibited from congregating, frequenting, playing or loitering upon the street, sidewalk, alley or public grounds in the city between the hours of 11:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, both inclusive, and 12:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday, both inclusive, unless accompanied by a parent, guardian or a person of the age of 21 years or more, with parental or guardian approval; or unless such minor is engaged in some business or occupation which such minor may lawfully engage in making it necessary to be in such places after said curfew, or unless the minor specified in this section is attending with the consent of parent or guardian, an approved school function that would extend beyond the curfew deadline specified in this section. **Section 7.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effective from and after its passage, and publication in the official city newspaper.
