ORDINANCE NO. 473

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XI, PUBLIC OFFENSES, ARTICLE 11-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 11-101 of the code of the City of Basehor is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-101 INCORPORATED UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Basehor, Kansas that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2005, prepared and published in book by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance" and to which shall be attached a copy of this article and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. That all ordinances found to be in conflict with the said "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities, Edition of 2005" be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effective from and after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
