

**ORDINANCE INCORPORATING  
THE 1997 STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES BY REFERENCE  
(Published July 24, 1997)**

**ORDINANCE NO. 314**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS, CHAPTER XIV, CONCERNING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCES AND LOCAL TRAFFIC REGULATIONS AS WELL AS ORDINANCE NO. 314.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:**

Section 1: That the Code of Ordinances, City of Basehor, Kansas, Chapter XIV, Traffic, Article 1 Standard Traffic Ordinance and Ordinance No. 295 shall be amended as follows:

**14-101. Standard Traffic Ordinance For Kansas Cities-Adopted.**

The Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, Edition of 1997, is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set forth at length and that the provisions therein shall be controlling within the area of jurisdiction of the city.

**14-102. Same - Marked copies on file.**

There shall be not less than three copies of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, Edition of 1997, marked and stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by Ordinance No. 314," with all sections and portions thereof intended to be omitted clearly marked to show any such omission or showing sections, articles, chapters, parts or portions that are incorporated, as the case may be, and to which shall be attached a copy of the incorporation ordinance, filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable business hours.

**14-103. Ordinance traffic infractions and violations fine schedule.**

(a) The fine schedule for all municipal ordinance traffic violations shall be not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00, but this shall not limit the fine which may be imposed following a court appearance except an appearance made for the purpose of pleading guilty or no contest to the violation; provided, that the following traffic violations are specifically excluded from such schedule of fines:

- (1) Reckless driving;
- (2) Driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs;

(3) Driving without a valid license issued or on a suspended or revoked license; or

(4) Offenses arising from a motor vehicle collision or accident.

(b) The schedule of fines for traffic violations shall be as established by the municipal judge pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A 12-4305.

**14-104. Same; Traffic infractions and traffic offenses.**


(a) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this article that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A Supp. 8-2118.

(b) All traffic violations which are included within this article, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions as defined in subsection (a) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses. (Code 1989)

Section 2: That the sections amended herein and all sections in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
