

**ORDINANCE INCORPORATING
THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES BY REFERENCE
(Published July 24, 1997)**

ORDINANCE NO. 313

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS, CHAPTER XI, CONCERNING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE ORDINANCES AND LOCAL TRAFFIC REGULATIONS AS WELL AS ORDINANCE NO. 313.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

Section 1: That the Code of Ordinances, City of Basehor, Kansas, Chapter XI, Public Offenses, Article 1 Uniform Offense Code and Ordinance No. 272 shall be amended as follows:

11-101. Uniform Offense Code

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Basehor, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities," edition of 1997, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 313," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable office hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Uniform Public Offense Code similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.


Section 2: REPEAL.

Ordinance number 272 and any other ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel.
