

**ORDINANCE NO. 311**

**AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SPEED FROM 30 MILES PER HOUR TO 20 MILES PER HOUR; AND AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF TWO SIGNS UNDER THE ENTITLEMENT "WANTED OUR CHILDREN ALIVE" TO BE POSTED AT 155TH STREET AND CRESTWOOD DRIVE AND AT 155TH STREET AND ELM STREET IN THE CRESTWOOD COUNTRY ESTATES SUBDIVISION.**

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the City of Basehor that the speed limit should be reduced from 30 miles per hour to 20 miles per hour in the Crestwood Country Estates Subdivision; and

**WHEREAS**, speed restriction is within the jurisdiction and control of the City of Basehor, Leavenworth County, Kansas; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the City of Basehor that a sign entitled "WANTED OUR CHILDREN ALIVE" be posted at 155th Street and Crestwood Drive and 155th Street and Elm Street, Crestwood Country Estates Subdivision.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:**

Section 1. That the speed limit shall be reduced from 30 miles per hour to 20 miles per hour in the Crestwood Country Estates Subdivision.

Section 2. That speed limit signs shall be posted on said 155th Street and Crestwood Drive and 155th Street and Elm Street, Crestwood Country Estates Subdivision.

Section 3. That signs entitled, "WANTED OUR CHILDREN ALIVE" be posted at 155th Street and Crestwood Drive and 155th Street and Elm Street, Crestwood Country Estates Subdivision.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel newspaper.
