

ORDINANCE NO. 310

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SPEED ON 152nd STREET FROM 30 MILES PER HOUR TO 20 MILES PER HOUR; AND AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF TWO SIGNS UNDER THE ENTITLEMENT "WANTED OUR CHILDREN ALIVE" TO BE POSTED AT 152nd STREET AND CHESTNUT AND AT 152nd STREET AND PARALLEL.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City of Basehor that the speed limit should be reduced from 30 miles per hour to 20 miles per hour on 152nd Street; and

WHEREAS, speed restriction is within the jurisdiction and control of the City of Basehor, Leavenworth County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City of Basehor that a sign entitled, "WANTED OUR CHILDREN ALIVE" be posted at 152nd Street and Chestnut and one posted at 152nd Street and Parallel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

Section 1. That the speed limit shall be reduced from 30 miles per hour to 20 miles per hour on 152nd Street.

Section 2. That speed limit signs shall be posted on said 152nd Street as soon as practical.


Section 3. That signs entitled, "WANTED OUR CHILDREN ALIVE" be posted at 152nd Street and Chestnut and at 152nd Street and Parallel.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel.
