

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS AND INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES", EDITION OF 1993, WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS, CHANGES AND ADDITIONS; PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND MODIFYING AND AMENDING CHAPTER XIV TRAFFIC ARTICLE 1 AND ARTICLE 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

Section 1. Chapter XIV Traffic Article 14-101 is hereby amended and modified as follows:

14-101: INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Basehor, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities", Edition of 1993, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed, such incorporation being authorized by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, inclusive, as amended. No fewer than three copies of said standard ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Basehor, Kansas," with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this section, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. Section 2. Chapter XIV Traffic Article 14-203 is hereby amended and modified as follows:

14-203: TRUCKS, BUSES, ETC.; PARKING RESTRICTED.

(a) It shall be unlawful to park any bus, truck, tractor, tractor-trailer combination, industrial equipment, or like conveyances, having a state licensing rating of one ton or more upon a residential street within the city for any period of time exceeding two hours. For the purposes of this section, the word tractor shall include both road tractors and farm tractors. (Ord. 176, Sec. 1).

(b) **Vehicles with a weight of 2 tons or over.** It shall be unlawful for any bus [excluding any school buses], truck, tractor, tractor-trailer combination, industrial equipment, or like conveyances, having a weight of 2 tons or more to drive or park upon a residential street within the City of Basehor unless such a vehicle is picking up or delivering merchandise.

Section 3. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the municipal judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall not be less than 10.00 nor more than 500.00 except for speeding which shall be not less than 32.00 nor more than 500.00. A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$500.00.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel.
