

**ORDINANCE 265**

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON LEAVENWORTH ROAD FROM 155TH STREET TO 158TH STREET.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City of Basehor that parking on Leavenworth Road between 155th Street and 158th Street is not compatible with normal and safe movement of traffic and pedestrians along Leavenworth Road; and

WHEREAS, roadways are under the jurisdiction and control of the City of Basehor, Leavenworth County, Kansas.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

**Section 1.** It shall be unlawful for any person to park, or fail to remove a vehicle of any kind parked along either side of Leavenworth Road from 155th Street west to 158th Street, Basehor, Kansas, Leavenworth County, Kansas. Said Leavenworth Road shall be properly marked with no parking signs.

**Section 2.** The Chief of Police or any law enforcement officer of the City of Basehor may cause cars or other vehicles to be towed away which are parked on said street. Any cars or vehicles thus towed away may be reclaimed by the owner after paying a towing fee and/or storage.

**Section 3.** Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
