

ORDINANCE NO. 267

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 30 MPH TO 20 MPH IN KLAMM'S SUBDIVISION AND RANKIN SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City of Basehor that a speed limit in the Klamm Subdivision and in the Rankin Subdivision should be reduced from 30 mph to 20 mph; and

WHEREAS, speed restriction is within the jurisdiction and control of the City of Basehor, Leavenworth County, Kansas.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

Section 1. That the speed limit for any roadways located within the perimeters of the Klamm Subdivision and the perimeters of the Rankin Subdivision shall be reduced from 30 mph to 20 mph.

Section 2. That speed limit signs shall be posted in said subdivisions on all streets as soon as practical.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel.
