

ORDINANCE NO. 268

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THAT A STOP SIGN BE PLACED ON 157TH STREET AT KLAMM AND THAT A STOP SIGN BE PLACED ON POPLAR STREET AT 157TH STREET.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City of Basehor that a stop sign should be located at 157th Street at Klamm and that a stop sign should also be located at Poplar at 157th Street.

WHEREAS, roadways are under the jurisdiction and control of the City of Basehor, Leavenworth County, Kansas.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

Section 1. That a stop sign shall be located at 157th Street at Klamm Street and that a stop sign should be located at Popular Street at 157th Street.

Section 2. Said stop sign shall be in conformity with the City's Traffic Sign Ordinance and shall be place at said locations as soon as practical.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel.
