

ORDINANCE NO. 271

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES", EDITION OF 1994, WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS, CHANGES AND ADDITIONS; PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND MODIFYING AND AMENDING CHAPTER XIV TRAFFIC ARTICLE 1 AND ARTICLE 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

**Section 1.** Chapter XIV Traffic Article 14-101 is hereby amended and modified as follows:

**14-101: INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.**


There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Basehor, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities", Edition of 1994, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed, such incorporation being authorized by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, inclusive, as amended. No fewer than three copies of said standard ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Basehor, Kansas," with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this section, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. **Section 2. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES.** The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the municipal judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall not be less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00 except for speeding which shall be not less than \$32.00 nor more than \$500.00. A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$500.00.


**Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel.
