

**ORDINANCE INCORPORATING  
THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES BY REFERENCE  
(Published August 24, 1994)**

**ORDINANCE NO. 272**

An ordinance regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Basehor, Kansas; Incorporating by reference the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities," edition of 1994; and repealing ordinance number 260.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR:

**Section 1. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE.** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Basehor, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities," edition of 1994, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 272," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city cler to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable office hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.


**Section 2. Repeal.** Ordinance number 260 is hereby repealed.

**Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel.
