

ORDINANCE NO. 274

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING FINES FOR PERSONS ALLOWING DOGS AND CATS TO RUN AT LARGE WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF BASEHOR, KANSAS, AMENDING BASEHOR MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2-206.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

Section 1. Basehor Municipal Code section 2-206 shall be amended to read as follows:

- (a) It shall be unlawful for the owner or harbinger of any dog or cat to permit such dog or cat to run at large within the city at any time.
- (b) Any dog or cat running at large within the city shall be impounded as set out in Section 2-207.
- (c) Every person convicted of violating subsection (a), shall be deemed guilty of an infraction and shall pay the cost of the board bill and, upon first conviction pay a fine in the amount of \$25.00, upon second conviction pay a fine in the amount of \$50.00, and, upon a third or subsequent conviction pay a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00.


Section 2. Basehor Municipal Code section 2-206(d) is hereby repealed.
