

ORDINANCE NO. 278

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCES WITH REGARD TO CITY PARKS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

**Section 1.** Section 12-104 of the Code of the City of Basehor is hereby amended and modified as follows:

**12-104: DANGEROUS WEAPONS NOT ALLOWED.**

(A) Except as provided in subsection (B), it shall be unlawful for any person to bring upon any park property any firearm or dangerous weapon, including, but not limited to, archery bows, crossbows, slingshots, BB guns, Air Guns, Spring Air Guns, or any type of gun which uses any type of gas to propel a projectile.

(B) The provisions of subsection (A) shall not apply to duly authorized law enforcement officers acting in their official capacity.

**Section 2.** Section 12-105 of the Code of the City of Basehor is hereby amended and modified as follows:

**12-105: VEHICLE REGULATIONS.**

(A) All motor vehicles operated within a city park shall be subject to all traffic ordinances and regulations of the City of Basehor.

(B) It shall be unlawful to operate a motor vehicle in a city park except upon established streets, roads, drives and parking lots.

(C) It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle in a city park except in an area designated for such purpose.

(D) Except when a special hazard exists that requires lower speed, no person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 10 miles per hour within the boundaries of any city park.

**Section 3.** Section 12-108 of the Code of the City of Basehor is hereby amended and modified as follows:

**12-108: CAMPING PROHIBITED.**

Overnight camping is hereby prohibited in city parks except by resolution of the City Council.

**Section 4.** A new section 12-113 of the Code of the City of Basehor is hereby adopted:

**12-113: PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS CHAPTER.**

Except as otherwise provided by this Code, any person, individual, partnership, corporation or association who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance is guilty of an ordinance violation, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment of not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day any violation hereof is found to exist or continues to exist shall be a separate offense and punishable as such hereunder.

**Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel.
