

**ORDINANCE NO. 364**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 (Traffic) ARTICLE 2,  
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF  
BASEHOR, KANSAS:**

Section 1. The code of the City of Basehor is hereby amended by adding sections which read as follows:


14-216 REDUCING SPEED LIMIT (a) The speed limit on 155<sup>th</sup> Street, from the north boundary of Pin Oak Subdivision to the north city limit, shall be reduced from 40 mph and restored to the maximum speed for a residential zone of 30 mph in accordance with K.S.A. 8-1558.

14-217 PLACING A STOP SIGN (a) A stop sign shall be located on 154<sup>th</sup> Street, at the intersection of Martha/Ripley Streets.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effective from and after its passage, and publication in the official city newspaper.
