**ORDINANCE NO. 653**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS, AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF STORMWATER DRAINAGE AND SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY TO PAY THE COSTS THEREOF.**

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**WHEREAS**, K.S.A. 12-631r(a) *et seq.* (the “Act”) provides, in part, that whenever the governing body of any city determines it is necessary to construct storm sewers, channels, retention basins or drains for the purpose of managing the storm drainage areas of all or any portion of such city and in the unincorporated areas outside of but within three miles of the corporate limits of such city, the governing body may authorize the construction of such storm sewers, channels, retention basins or drains, such construction shall be authorized by ordinance; such ordinance shall designate where such storm sewers, channels, retention basins or drains shall be located; and

**WHEREAS**, Charter Ordinance No. 25 (the “Charter Ordinance”) of the City of Basehor, Kansas (the “City”), authorizes the City to operate and maintain sewers and disposal works for the collection and purification of the sewage of the City and to issue general obligation bonds to pay all of a part of any costs thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the City hereby finds and determines that it is necessary to construct storm sewer improvements and related sanitary sewer improvements within the corporate limits of the City described as follows (collectively the “Project”):

The remedying of certain ditch erosion and storm water drainage issues in order to prevent flooding and the exposure and possible damage of sewer laterals from residences to the main sewer line, and other necessary and appurtenant improvements, all located [within the area bordered on the north by Parallel Street, the west by 155th Street, the south by Landauer Avenue, and the east by North 153rd Terrace].

; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the City hereby further finds and determines that general obligation bonds of the City should be issued under the authority of the Act and the Charter Ordinance to pay the costs of the Project and related financing costs.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:**

**Section 1. Findings.** It is hereby found and determined that the Project be constructed. The estimated construction and engineering costs of the Project are \$350,000.

**Section 2. Financing.** The costs of the Project, interest on interim financing and associated financing costs shall be payable from the proceeds of general obligation bonds of the City issued under authority of the Act.

**Section 3. Reimbursement.** Any bonds issued under the authority of this Ordinance may be used to reimburse expenditures made on or after the date that is 60 days before the date of passage of this Ordinance pursuant to U.S. Treasury Regulation §1.150-2.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication once in the official City newspaper.

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**PASSED** by the governing body of the City on June 15, 2015 and **APPROVED AND SIGNED** by the Mayor.
