ORDINANCE NO. 481

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF "WATCH OUT FOR CHILDREN" SIGNS ON PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City of Basehor that "Watch Out For Children" signs should be erected on public streets within the City of Basehor, Ks; and

WHEREAS, roadways are under the jurisdiction and control of the City of Basehor, Leavenworth County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

Section 1. That "Watch Out For Children" signs shall be erected with the exact locations being determined by the Public Works City Superintendent.

Section 2. That said signs shall be in conformity with the City's Traffic Sign Ordinance requirements and shall be placed at said locations as soon as practical.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Basehor Sentinel newspaper.
