

ORDINANCE NO. 328A

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING 156TH STREET WHICH LIES BETWEEN
LEAVENWORTH ROAD AND KLAMM STREET LOCATED IN THE CITY OF
BASEHOR, KANSAS.**

WHEREAS, the Basehor Planning Commission has recommended in conjunction with the approval of a site plan for a proposed parking lot the Basehor/Linwood Elementary School the vacation of the street right-of-way through the school property;
and

WHEREAS, the street right-of-way is encompassed within the school property;
and


WHEREAS, no private rights will be injured or endangered by such vacation and that the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience by the vacation of said right-of-way;
and

WHEREAS, after legal notice and public hearing as required by statute, no objections have been filed with the City Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Basehor, Kansas:

Section 1: That 156th Street located between Leavenworth Road and Klam Street be and the same is hereby vacated pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-504, et. seq.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be effective upon passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper for the City of Basehor, Kansas, as provided by law.
